Only dues paying members in good standing will be able to attend this meeting and vote on the TA (Tentative Agreement). #### Stamp of "Reasonable Assurance"

The stamp of "Reasonable Assurance" (for work next school year) should be on your paycheck on May 31, 2019. Please keep in mind that the stamp is not a guarantee of work and you could still be laid off. The LPA contract indicates that members shall be notified of layoff "at least two week prior to the end of the school year."

If you have elected cash in lieu of medical insurance, it will be paid on the 5/31/19 pay date. Please keep in mind if you were laid off on June 30, 2018 and not called back until September or later, the amount you will be reimbursed will reflect that.

If you intend to use vacation time before the end of the year, you must enter it into Aesop no later than May 31st, 2019.


