We thought it would be nice to highlight what your Executive Board members contribute to the LPA. Each month we will feature a different duty. They can also be found in our by-laws.


Curious what a Cluster Rep does?

The duties of the Cluster Representative collect monthly data and report the data monthly at the Executive Board meeting. This is a great reason your cluster rep is your first stop for communication!

They will also communicate monthly with the building representatives to answer questions from the building, assist in representation concerns, and help to solve local building problems.

If needed the LPA President can request the cluster rep to participate in reviewing grievances filed by LPA members and that have been denied at the District level, to determine whether or not the grievance has merit to proceed to arbitration.
